The Court made the following:

ORDER:

This Writ Petition is filed for a *Mandamus* to declare the action of respondent Nos.2 and 3 in not considering the petitioner's representation, dated 20.8.2014, as illegal and arbitrary.

Mr. P.Bhakthavatsal, learned counsel for the petitioner addressed letter, dated 23.11.2015, to the Registrar (Judicial) of this Court stating that his client is not interested in pursuing this Writ Petition.

At the hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner reiterated the contents of the said letter and requested for permission of the Court to withdraw the Writ Petition.

The Writ Petition is, accordingly, dismissed as withdrawn.

As a sequel to dismissal of the Writ Petition, W.P.M.P.No.36450 of 2014 shall stand dismissed as infructuous.
