Criminal Petition No. 5699 of 2015

Order:

This Criminal Petition is filed by the petitioners/A3 and A5, under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, seeking to quash the FIR registered against them in FIR No.16 of 2015 on the file of Women U/G Police Station, Kadapa, registered for the offences punishable under Section 498A IPC.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor representing the State.

3. A perusal of the record would show that there is material, *prima facie*, sufficient to investigate into the allegations made against the petitioners/A3 and A5 in the FIR. There are no valid grounds to quash the FIR.

4. In the facts and circumstances of the case and as requested by the learned counsel for the petitioners, the Criminal Petition is disposed of directing the Station House Officer, Women U/G Police Station, Kadapa, not to arrest the petitioners herein/A3 and A5, however, the investigation shall continue to its logical end and the petitioners shall co-operate with the investigating agency for smooth completion of the investigation.

As a sequel thereto, the miscellaneous applications, if any, pending in the Criminal Petition shall stand closed.
