ORDER:

_____ This petition is filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. to quash the proceedings in C.C.No.52 of 2015 on the file of the Court of the II Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Vijayawada.

_____ The learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission of this Court to permit the petitioners to withdraw the criminal petition. He further submitted that the presence of the petitioners may be dispensed with before the trial Court on each and every date of adjournment.

_____ Permission is granted.

_____ There is no dispute with regard to the identity of the petitioners. Even if their presence is dispensed with, no prejudice will be caused to the second respondent.

_____ Hence, the Criminal Petition is dismissed as withdrawn. The presence of the petitioners, who are accused Nos.2 to 4 in C.C.No.52 of 2015, before the trial Court is hereby dispensed with on each and every date of adjournment. However, they shall appear before the trial Court as and when their presence is so required.

_____ Consequently, Miscellaneous Petitions, if any, pending in this Criminal Petition, shall stand closed.
