

**HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE VILAS V.AFZULPURKAR**

**W.P.No.33891 of 2015**

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**ORDER:**

Heard.

The grievance of the petitioner is that his application under Form 6-A filed on 02-09-2015 is not being considered and disposed of by the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent.

The averments of the affidavit speak that the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent is waiting for the orders from the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent.

However, under the A.P.Rights in Land and Pattadar Pass Books Act, 1971, it is the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent, who is the competent authority, to examine such request and take appropriate decision in accordance with law.

Since the petitioner made application only on 02-09-2015, the writ petition is disposed of directing the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent to examine the said request in accordance with law and pass appropriate orders, expeditiously, preferably within six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. No order as to costs.

Miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending in this writ petition shall stand closed.
