ORDER:

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Standing Counsel appearing for the respondents.

2. With the consent of both parties, the Writ Petition is disposed of at the admission stage.

3. The writ petition is filed seeking to issue a writ of *Mandamus* to declare the action of the respondents in issuing proceedings vide Ref.No.SRP/PER/2-006/3512, dated 10/14.08.2015, declaring the petitioner as fit for the same job without conducting proper medical examination and without assessing the actual physical condition though he is suffering from Epilepsy as illegal and arbitrary, and consequently, to grant all the consequential benefits.

4. Though the writ petition is filed urging various grounds, learned counsel for the petitioner restricts his prayer seeking a direction to the respondents to dispose of the representation made by the petitioner in the month of June, 2015 and pass appropriate orders at the earliest.

5. Learned Standing Counsel for the respondents did not dispute the same.

6. Without going into the merits of the case and having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, the Writ Petition is disposed of by directing the respondents to pass appropriate orders on the representation made by the petitioner in the month of June, 2015, in accordance with law and taking regard to the order, dated 30.9.2015, passed in W.P.No.31497 of 2015 of this Court, as early as possible, preferably, within a period of six (6) weeks from the date of receipt of a

copy of this order. There shall be no order as to costs.

7. Miscellaneous Petitions pending, if any, in this Writ Petition shall stand closed.
