Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the Affidavit filed herein the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order or Direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the auction notice dated 23-01-2015 issued by the Respondent No.4 for conducting auction of the shops belonging to the respondent No.4 for lease for a period of 3 years, in so far as Shop No. 19 belonging to the respondent No.4 without considering the representation of the Petitioner submitted to the Respondent No.4 for extension of the lease for a period of 3 years in respect of the Shop No. 19 situated at Devalayam Road, Sri Danthuluri Jagannadha Raju Chowltry Shopping Complex, Bhimavaram - 2, West Godavari District belonging to the respondent No.4 as per the Circular No. 9 in Rc.
