

THE HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE CHALLA KODANDA RAM

WRIT PETITION No. 5888 of 2015

ORDER:

The writ petitioners are aggrieved of the action of the 1st respondent-revisional authority in not passing orders in the revision or in the stay application filed by them against the orders of the 2nd respondent, dated 17.01.2015.

2. The averments in the writ affidavit are to the effect that 3rd respondent-Special Deputy Collector took up LTR proceedings against the petitioners and passed eviction orders on 22.04.2006. Challenging the same, the petitioners filed an appeal before the 2nd respondent-Additional Agent. But the 2nd respondent, by orders dated 17.01.2015, confirmed the eviction orders of the 3rd respondent. Impugning the orders of the 2nd respondent, the petitioners filed a revision petition before the 1st respondent, and along with the revision, they filed a stay petition seeking stay of eviction orders. The petitioners grievance is that the 1st respondent has neither disposed of the Stay application nor the Revision.

3. Heard the petitioners' counsel and the learned Government Pleader.

4. Considering the fact that the Revision as well as the Stay application are pending before the 1st respondent, this writ petition can be disposed of by directing the 1st respondent to dispose of the Stay application, or preferably the Revision itself, within a period of three months from today. Till such time the Stay Petition or the Revision, whichever is earlier, is disposed of, there shall be Stay of eviction proceedings against the petitioners.

5. With the above direction, the writ petition is disposed of. No costs. Miscellaneous petitions, if any pending in this writ petition, shall stand closed.
