ORDER:

The criminal petition is filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. to quash the

proceedings in Cr.No.78 of 2015 of Tukaramgate Police Station, Hyderabad City.

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor, representing the State.

Basing on the complaint lodged by the 2nd respondent/complainant the police registered a case against the petitioner for the offences punishable under Sections 406, 420, 463, 464, 468 and 506 IPC.

The allegations in the complaint, *prima facie*, reveal the commission of offence punishable under Sections 406, 420, 463, 464, 468 and 506 IPC by the petitioner. This is a matter, which requires investigation by the police, and there are no valid grounds to quash the First Information Report.

In view of the facts and circumstances of the case and as requested by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the Criminal Petition is disposed of, directing the investigating agency to proceed with the investigation, however, without arresting the petitioner/accused in Cr.No.78 of 2015 of Tukaramgate Police Station, Hyderabad City.

Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand closed in consequence.
