The Court made the following:

ORDER:

This company petition is filed for an order to wind up the

respondent for non-payment of the debt, allegedly, due to the petitioner.

Sri N.V.Shravan Kumar, learned counsel representing Sri Challa Gunaranjan, learned counsel for the respondent, filed a memo, dated 19.01.2015, on behalf of the respondent along with a settlement agreement, dated 09.01.2015, between the petitioner and the respondent.

Sri Tarun G.Reddy, learned counsel representing Sri C.Tulasi Krishna, learned counsel for the petitioner, submitted that the aforementioned memo along with the settlement agreement may be taken on record and the company petition may be closed.
