ORDER: (Per the Hon'ble The Chief Justice Sri Kalyan Jyoti Sengupta)

This matter has been time and again adjourned at the request of the learned counsel hoping that the parties will settle the same amicably outside the Court. Till today we do not see the sign of settlement. Therefore, we pass the following order.

Within fortnight from date if the matter is settled amicably then the parties will follow the settlement.
