The Court made the following:

COMMON ORDER:

These Writ Petitions are filed for identical reliefs,

viz., for declaring the inaction of respondent No.2 in removing the alleged unauthorised constructions made by the private respondents.

After arguing the case, Mr. Suresh Shiv Sagar, learned counsel for the petitioners, requested for permission to unconditionally withdraw the Writ Petitions upon realising that the same are vexatious in nature.
