COMMON ORDER:

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C by the petitioners/A1 to A3 seeking to quash the proceedings in C.C.No.2553 of 2013 on the file of XIX Metropolitan Magistrate, Cyberabad at Miyapur, where the learned Magistrate has taken cognizance for the offence punishable under Sections 498-A I.P.C. and Sections 4 and 5 of the Dowry Prohibition Act, which is an out come of the report of the 2nd respondent/*de facto* complainant in crime No.539 of 2012 of K.P.H.B. Police Station, Cyberabad District, from which police after investigation filed final report that was taken cognizance by the learned Magistrate.

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned counsel for respondents.

Pending the Criminal Petition, the *de facto* complainant filed petition seeking permission of the Court to compound the offence.

A1 as GPA holder to represent A2 and A3 and the 2nd respondent/*de facto* complainant are present before the Court and they are identified by their respective counsel and filed joint memo with affidavit stating that they amicably settled the

matter outside the Court at the intervention of elders by paying a sum of Rs.9,50,000/- to the *de facto* complainant, out of which Rs.5 lakhs already paid to her, Rs.2 lakhs at the time of withdrawal of C.C. and the balance amount of Rs.2,50,000/- at

the time of disposal of divorce case to be paid. The *de facto* complainant has stated that she has received Rs.7 lakhs and balance Rs.2,50,000/- to be paid at the time of divorce case. Hence, permission to be accorded to compound the offence.

Having regard to the said circumstances, the complainant is permitted to compound the offence with the accused pending criminal petition before this Court.

Accordingly, CrI.M.P.No.7446 of 2015 is ordered and the Criminal Petition is allowed by quashing the proceedings in C.C.No.2553 of 2013 on the file of XIX Metropolitan Magistrate, Cyberabad at Miyapur.

Miscellaneous petitions pending if any, shall stand closed.
