CRIMINAL REVISION CASE No.1853 OF 2015

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ORDER:

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1. The petitioner-owner of the vehicle filed this Criminal Revision Case under Sections 397 and 401 of the Criminal Procedure Code being aggrieved by the order dated 25.08.2015 passed by the Judicial First Class Magistrate at Arakuvalley in CrI.M.P.No.647 of 2015 in Crime No.145 of 2015-16.

2. Heard and perused the material available on record.

3. Petitioner herein filed the impugned application seeking to release the crime vehicle TATA 409 Van bearing No.AP 35X 4419 and the said application was dismissed by the learned Magistrate. Challenging the same, present revision is filed.

4. Learned Counsel for the petitioner submitted that if the vehicle is kept idle for a long period there is every possibility of getting it damaged.

5. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor submitted that interim custody of the crime vehicle can be granted to the petitioner by imposing certain conditions.

6. Considering the above facts and circumstances of the case, it is directed that the vehicle in question i.e. TATA 409 Van bearing No.AP 35X 4419. shall be released for interim custody of the petitioner, subject to final orders to be passed at the time of disposal of main case, on his executing a personal bond for a sum of Rs.2,00,000/- (Rupees Two lakhs only) with one surety for the like sum to the satisfaction of the Judicial First Class Magistrate, Arakuvalley, and also on production of original R.C. book. The petitioner is directed to file an affidavit before the Court below undertaking that he shall not alienate the vehicle, shall not change the physical features of the same till the disposal of the criminal case, and further he shall produce the

vehicle as and when required by the Court concerned.

7. Accordingly, the Criminal Revision Case is disposed of.
Miscellaneous petitions filed in this revision, if any, shall stand closed.
