ORDER: (per the Hon'ble The Chief Justice Sri Kalyan Jyoti Sengupta)

The writ petition is frivolous, as it appears from the record that the writ petitioner is alleged to have called for a lady, who is illegally detained by her father.

We are of the view that the petitioner has no right to claim custody or get the company of the lady right now. There is no relationship developed between the petitioner and herself as jural, legal, or personal relationship.
