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ORDER:-

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned government pleader for Revenue.

2. Questioning the action of the fourth respondent in not taking any action on the representation of the petitioner dated 08.03.2015 for issuance of pattadar passbook and title deed, this writ petition is filed.

3. It is, however, found that petitioner has not made application as per the prescribed proforma under Form 6A in accordance with the Rules framed under the A.P. Rights in Land and Pattadar Passbooks Act, 1971. Hence, petitioner is granted liberty to make appropriate application in accordance with the Rules while enclosing the copies of the judgments of the civil court and if such an application is made, the fourth respondent shall consider the same and pass appropriate orders within 45 days of receipt of such application.

With the above direction, writ petition is disposed of. As a sequel, the miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand closed. There shall be no order as to costs.
