Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the Affidavit filed here in the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS declaring the action of respondents 1 and 2 in issuing possession notice dt. 29.10.2014 and notice prior to sale dt. 06.02.2015 and insisting the petitioners to vacate from their respective site and house properties, without notifying properties of respondents 3 and 4 for sale, as illegal, irregular, irrational, discriminatory and violative of the provisions of Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002 and rules framed there under and offends Articles 14, 21 and 300-A of Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondents not to dispossess the petitioners nor sell their properties, without first subjecting properties of respondents 3 and 4 for realization of amount due

WPMP. NO. 5397 OF 2015: Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C. Praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in W.P. the High Court may be pleased to order stay of all further proceedings including dispossession of petitioners from their respective properties pursuant to possession notice dt. 29.10.2014 and notice prior to sale dt. 06.02.2015 issued by 1st respondent, pending disposal of WP No. 4063 of 2015 on the file of the High Court.
