ORDER:

This writ petition is filed for the following relief:

“To issue a Writ, order or direction especially one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring that G.O.Ms.No.43, Agriculture & Cooperation (AGRI.II) Department, dated:19-9-2014 is illegal and arbitrary and therefore liable to be set-aside and pass.....”
