This is an application under Section 11(6) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 for the appointment of an arbitrator.

2. The existence of the agreement containing the arbitration clause is admitted. In fact, an arbitrator had been appointed earlier. This mandate came to an end as the award had not been made and published within the time stipulated by the parties.

3. The application is, therefore, disposed of by directing the respondents to appoint an arbitrator in accordance with clause 49 by 31.07.2015 failing which it will be open to the applicant to make an application in this application itself for having an arbitrator named by this Court.
