This is an application under Section 11 (6) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 for the appointment of an arbitrator.

2. The parties entered into an agreement clause 14 whereof reads as under:-

“14. In case of any dispute or difference arising out of the implementation or interpretations of any of the clauses of this agreement, these will be endeavoured to be settled by mutual negotiations failing which the matter will be referred to the Secretary, Information Technology, Chandigarh Administration whose decision will be final and binding on both the parties.”

3. The application is disposed of by appointing the Secretary, Information Technology, Chandigarh Administration as the sole arbitrator.

4. The respondents shall inform the applicant the name of the arbitrator forthwith upon receipt of a certified copy of this order.
