This is an application under Section 11(6) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 for the appointment of an arbitrator.

2. The agreement is admitted by the respondent. The clause relating to arbitration reads as under:-

“32.2 Arbitration

32.2.1. Arbitrator

In the event of any dispute arising between the parties in relation to or under this agreement, the same shall be settled by arbitration conducted by a sole arbitrator. CEO of the Company (Authority) will be the sole arbitrator. The decision of the arbitration shall be final and binding.

32.2.2. Place of Arbitration

The place of arbitration shall be Amritsar.”

3. The arbitrator is specified in the clause itself.

4. The petition is disposed of by directing that the arbitration shall proceed with the CEO of the respondent as the sole arbitrator.
