This is an application under Section 11(5) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 for the appointment of an arbitrator.

Sodhi, former Chief Justice of the Karnataka High Court as the sole arbitrator. The parties, however, agree that the venue of the arbitration shall be Chandigarh despite the arbitration clause.
