The order dated 14.08.2012 of the Writ Court, the non compliance of which has been alleged relates to the release of certain retiral benefits in the light of the fact that the petitioner has superannuated in the year 2006. It mandated the respondents authorities to consider the claim of the petitioner and decide the representation within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. That being the solitary mandate, the respondents plead compliance as retiral benefits have been released to him even prior to the filing of the contempt petition.

In view of the fact that retiral dues are released, the contempt petition is disposed of as having been rendered satisfied leaving the petitioner to his remedies of raising the issue of short fall of payment, if any, with the respondents.
