Short reply by way of affidavit of the Chairman-cum-Managing Director, Punjab State Power Corporation Limited (respondent herein), has been filed. Copy supplied to the petitioner, who appears in person. She has also been handed over two cheques bearing Nos.473890 and 473889 dated 11.03.2015 amounting to ₹14,23,678/- and ₹4,73,889/- respectively. Shri Karnail Singh Mann, Chief Engineer, Guru Nanak Dev Thermal Plant, Bathinda, states that all the payments due to the petitioner have been released. Petitioner states that she is entitled to interest on the delayed payment of General Provident Fund.

If that be so, she may make a representation to the Chief Engineer Guru Nanak Dev Thermal Plant, Bathinda, within a period of four weeks. On doing so, the same shall be considered and decided by the Chief Engineer, within a period of four weeks. In case the petitioner is entitled to any interest as claimed by her, the same be released to her within a period of four weeks thereafter. In case of non-acceptance of the claim of the petitioner, a well reasoned and speaking order be passed and conveyed to

The petition stands disposed of.
