Affidavit of S.K.Goyal, IAS, Director General, Industrial Training Department, 30 Bays Building, Sector 17, Chandigarh has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record.

The costs have been paid.

The dues of the petitioner pursuant to the award of the Labour Court as affirmed by the writ Court have since been released though with a great effort. The respondents have placed an interpretation on the order denying the benefit on the ground that the petitioner was gainfully employed whereas no such contingency was envisaged in the order of the writ Court. The Court could have taken a very serious note of the entire situation to conclude deliberate violation of the orders of the Court but finding that the orders now stand complied with and regrets expressed, I deem it appropriate to let the matter rest here and dispose of the instant petition as having become infructuous.
