Short reply on behalf of the respondent has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record. A copy thereof has been supplied to the counsel opposite.

The order dated 5.12.2014, non-compliance of which is alleged by the petitioners mandated the respondents to consider and decide the comprehensive representation made by the petitioners alongwith other representations already made by passing an appropriate order strictly in accordance with law, within a period of 2 months from the date of receipt of the said representation.

Reply indicates that needful has since been done and speaking orders passed. Respondents do not dispute the financial liability but are saying that as

and when funds are available, payments will be made to the petitioners.

In view of above, instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such, with liberty to the petitioners to challenge the order so passed in case they are dis-satisfied with the same. It is further directed that respondents will make the payments to the petitioners as early as possible but not later than three months from today.
