MAHESH GROVER, J.

The petitioner has alleged that the respondents have failed to remove the encroachments in terms of the directions by the writ Court. On an earlier occasion contempt petition was disposed of 11.8.2013 in view of the affidavit filed by the Additional Deputy Commissioner and the reports appended.

The petitioner now once again has levelled allegations of encroachment by stating that after the initial removal by the respondents the encroachers have re-possessed the land. An affidavit has been filed by BDPO, Doraha, Tehsil Payal, District Ludhiana on 5.7.2014 wherein factual position has been detailed in paras 3 to 6 and also stating that encroachments have been removed. Statements of the villagers have also been recorded to that effect.

There is no counter affidavit despite that this affidavit was filed more than one year back. Consequently, instant petition is disposed of as having become satisfied.
