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TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.

Learned counsel appearing for respondent No.2 has produced in Court today a copy of the speaking order dated 28.03.2014 passed by the Chairman, Ludhiana Improvement Trust Ludhiana. Copy of such order has been furnished to the counsel for the petitioner. Perusal of the same would reveal that the legal notice dated 10.05.2013 served by the petitioner has since been considered and allotment of plot No.95-B in Rishi Balamiki Nagar Scheme has been restored in favour of Hem Raj Mittal and consequently, the subsequent transfer of such plot in favour of the present petitioner has also been restored.

In the light of such factual position, the directions dated 18.10.2012 passed by the Division Bench of this Court while disposing of CWP No.21090 of 2012 stand complied with.

Accordingly, the contempt petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

Rule discharged.

Mr. J.S. Toor, Advocate further furnishes an assurance that possession of the plot would be handed over to the petitioner within a period of 8 weeks' from today subject to fulfillment of all requisite formalities.
