Counsel appearing for the respondents would submit that after the passing of the order dated 22.09.2014 passed by this Court, the earlier order dated 10.07.2013, whereby benefit of regularization had been denied to the petitioner has been withdrawn and a fresh order dated 05.11.2014 has been passed by the Executive Engineer, HUDA, Division No.3, Faridabad and in terms of which the petitioner has been granted the benefit of regularization w.e.f. 01.02.1996 as per terms and conditions contained in the order and even the consequential benefits in the nature of arrears etc. have been released and paid to the petitioner. Copy of the order dated 05.11.2014 has been furnished to the counsel for the petitioner in Court today.

In the light of such categorical stand taken, this Court is satisfied that there has been substantial and complete compliance of the judgment dated 08.11.2010 passed by this Court in CWP No.19640 of 2010.

Accordingly, the contempt petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
