In pursuance to the order dated 24.12.2014, passed by this Court, an affidavit dated 6.2.2015 of the B.D.P.O., Rayya, District Amritsar, has been filed in Court today and the same is taken on record. Copy has been furnished to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Perusal of the affidavit dated 6.2.2015 would reveal that a categorical assertion has been made that all the 180 shops of Guru Bazar, Baba Bakala Sahib which were a subject matter of acquisition for purposes of widening of the road, have since been demolished and the possession stands taken.

Mr. Bikramjit Singh, B.D.P.O, Rayya, District Amritsar, who is present in Court also suffers a statement that upon demolition the entire debris already stands removed.

In the light of such stand taken on behalf of the State, nothing survives in the instant contempt petition and the same is, accordingly, disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
