CWP No. 15140 of 1999, along with other connected Civil Writ Petitions were disposed of vide order dated 19.01.2011, whereby the order of demolition dated 14.10.1999, was quashed and the petitioners were given liberty to file objections to show cause notice dated 07.10.1999 within three weeks before the competent authority. It was directed that the competent authority shall pass an appropriate order after considering the reply or objections, if any, within three months.

In the reply filed by Sh. Pardeep Aggarwal, IAS, Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana, it has been stated that in compliance with the order of this Court, the order dated 22.08.2014 (Annexure R-1) has been passed, wherein after considering the representation of the petitioner and granting

personal hearing to them, it was concluded that the petitioners are illegal/unauthorized occupants of the land and they have no legal right to hold unlawful possession on the Municipal Land. Accordingly, their request to regularize their possession or allotment of alternate site is rejected.

Mr. Kamaldeep Singh Sidhu, learned Additional Advocate General, Punjab states that the aforesaid order was assailed by the petitioners by filing CWP No. 10359 of 2014, which was dismissed on 04.09.2014.

In view of the above, the order dated 19.01.2011 passed by this Court stands complied with and the present petition has become infructuous.

Disposed of as infructuous.
