Petitioners has filed CM-20005-CII of 2015 with a prayer for final disposal of the case as respondents have admitted the claim of the petitioners. It is submitted that instant contempt petition may be disposed of with direction to the respondents to release the benefit of higher pay scale to the petitioners within stipulated period. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that COCP No. 1135 of 2014 is fixed for 15.01.2016. Learned counsel has made an oral prayer that main petition may be pre-poned to today and the same be disposed of.
