The orders of the writ Court mandated reinstatement of the petitioner in service with continuity thereof without any monetary consequences. An amount of Rs.50,000/- as compensation was paid.

The respondents plead that it was impossible to carry out directions of this Court as the unit being run by them had been shut down. However, petitioner's dues have been calculated and given to him.

This reply was filed in August, 2015 and no counter affidavit has been filed by the petitioner.

Consequently, in view of the reply submitted by the respondents, instant petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
