The present contempt petition arose out of order dated 25.1.2012, passed by the Writ Court while disposing of CWP No.1514 of 2012.

In the reply furnished to the contempt petition, a categorical stand has been taken that in compliance of the directions issued by this Court, a speaking order dated 10.12.2012 already stood passed and in terms of which the services of the petitioners were directed to be regularized notionally from the year 1991. It has further been stated that by virtue of passing of a speaking order dated 10.12.2012 even the salary of the petitioners stands revised.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from Mr. Gurkirat Singh, Assistant Controller, Finance, Department of Cultural Affairs, Punjab would apprise the Court that even the arrears accruing w.e.f. 10.12.2012 on account of revision of salary already stand paid and released to the petitioners on 5.1.2015. Even a copy of the order in regard thereto has been handed over to learned counsel for the petitioners in Court today.

As such, this Court is satisfied that there has been complete compliance of the orders and directions passed by this Court. Contempt petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
