MAHESH GROVER, J.

Learned counsel for the respondents states that possession has been given to the petitioner. The only dispute which the petitioner agitates is regarding some rent for the period 2000 to 2013 out of which Rs. 13,000/- have been paid to the petitioner . The rate of rent is Rs.500/- per month.

Learned counsel for the respondents states that the respondent is in bad state as his wife is suffering from terminal illness and is therefore unable to pay the remaining amount.

At this stage, in the considered view of this Court, since possession has been handed over to the petitioner and some amount of rent paid, interest of justice would be served if present petition is disposed of without any further orders. Rule against the respondents is discharged.
