In pursuance to the last order dated 19.12.2014 passed by this Court, learned State counsel has produced in Court today an order dated 11.02.2015 passed by the Director, Secondary Education, Haryana in terms of which the petitioner has been promoted as Deputy Superintendent in the grade 9300-34800+3600 grade pay w.e.f. 14.09.2011 i.e. the date his junior Sh. Kulbhushan has been so promoted. A copy of such order has been handed over to the petitioner, who appears in person.

With the passing of the order dated 11.02.2015, this Court is satisfied that judgment rendered by this Court dated 09.11.2012 in CWP No.23165 of 2010 has been complied with in letter and spirit.

Accordingly, the contempt petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

Rule discharged.

It is directed that by virtue of the passing of the order dated

11.02.2015 and the petitioner having been promoted on a notional basis as

Deputy Superintendent w.e.f. 14.09.2011, the consequential benefits as regards revised pension and other admissible retiral benefits would be calculated and released to the petitioner expeditiously and in any case, within a period of two months from today.
