Learned senior counsel for respondent No.2 states that in compliance with the order passed by this Court on 14.11.2014, an affidavit has been filed. On the said basis, he submits that all earnest efforts would be made to fill up the post of Radiologist lying vacant, at the earliest. Counsel for the petitioner submits that he has no objection to the same, provided the same is done within some specified time.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is disposed of with directions to the respondents to make all earnest efforts to fill up the post of Radiologist lying vacant, within a period of four months from today, in case suitable candidates are available for the said post, in accordance with law.
