Rakesh Kumar Jain, J.

The petitioner has alleged that the order dated 22.08.2014 by which notice was issued to the respondent for 22.09.2014 and it was directed that the candidates selected by virtue of advertisement No.SSA/1154 (Annexure P-6) shall not be permitted to join, has been violated by the respondent.

The petitioner had served a legal notice before filing this petition to which the respondent had replied that “...*in reply to para no.3, it is stated that the copy of the order dated 22.08.2014 was received in the O/o Haryana School Shiksha Pariyojna Parishad on 4.9.2014 but the 16 candidates out of 17, had already been appointed as Hostel Warden against the advertisement no.SSA/1154 dated 6.8.2014. Further they joined their duties in different KGBVs before receiving the copy of the interim order dated 22.8.2014. Therefore, HSSPP has not violated the orders of the Hon'ble High Court*”.

Counsel for the petitioner has also admitted during the course of hearing that the copy of the order dated 22.08.2014 was not supplied to the respondents till 04.09.2014 which clearly means that there is no willful disobedience on the part of the respondents of the order dated 22.08.2014.

Consequently, the present contempt petition is hereby dismissed being denuded of any merit.
