Learned counsel for the petitioner pleads that he has no instructions from his client.

The petitioner had filed CRWP No. 1784 of 2013 seeking his release for a period of two months on medical ground.

The said petition was disposed of vide order dated 10.01.2014 with a direction to the Jail Superintendent to seek a report from the Medical Officer regarding the injury of the petitioner and ensure that he is provided necessary medical treatment. If it was found that the petitioner required any such treatment, which is not available in Jail then the Jail Superintendent may refer the matter to the competent authority for release of the petitioner on the ground of injury.

It appears that because of passage of time, the basis of the relief claimed by the petitioner no longer survives, perhaps that is the reason why he is not in touch with his counsel.

Dismissed for non prosecution.

However, liberty shall remain with the petitioner to revive this petition, if any, grievance, survives.
