AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Counsel for the petitioner states that the order passed by this Court stands complied with. He submits that vide order dated 09.01.2014 (Annexure R-1) passed by the Director, Public Instructions (SE), Punjab, the petitioner has not been granted the arrears of re-fixation of his pay. This, the counsel for the petitioner contends, is contrary to the decision of the respondents as they have already generalized the claim w.e.f. 26.09.2012 and, therefore, the petitioner is at least entitled to the arrears from that date onwards. He further states that he would file a representation to the respondents for release of the said benefits within a period of four

weeks from today.

If such a representation is made by the counsel for the petitioner within the time stated by him, the same shall be considered and decided by respondent No. 1 within a period of eight weeks from the date of submission of such representation along with the copy of this order. If any benefit is to be conferred upon the petitioner on acceptance of his representation, the said benefit be released to him within a period of further six weeks.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
