AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (Oral):

In pursuance to the order dated 08.09.2014 passed by this Court in the present contempt petition, the petitioner submitted a requisite application alongwith the undertaking. The said application/request was duly considered by the respondents and an order dated 10.04.2015 has been passed, according to which, SCF No.3, Sabzi Mandi, Sector 26, Chandigarh, has been resumed by the Chandigarh Administration because of violation of the conditions of allotment and thus the request of the petitioner has not been accepted.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous.

At this stage, counsel for the respondents very fairly states that in case, the petitioner submits an application/request alongwith the requisite documents for Shop-cum-Flat/Shop-cum-Office/valid premises in Sabzi Mandi Sector 26, Chandigarh, as per the order dated 08.09.2014 passed in this case, the same will be considered and if found to be in order in all respects, licence granted to the petitioner within a period of four weeks from the date of submission of valid application/request.

In case of any adverse order passed by the respondents, petitioner may avail of the remedy in accordance with law.
