Reply by way of affidavit of Gurjot Singh, DEO (EE), Ludhiana on behalf of the respondent no.4 and the same is taken on record. A copy thereof has been supplied to the counsel opposite.

The order dated 27.8.2014, non-compliance of which is alleged by the petitioner mandated the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner in accordance with policy of 2004 and in case the petitioner makes a complete and comprehensive representation within a period of 4 weeks from that date, respondents were directed to consider and decide the same as per latest policy of 2004 but not later than a period of 2 months from the date of receipt of the said representation.

Reply indicates that needful has since been done and a speaking order passed.

In view of above, instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such, with liberty to the petitioner to challenge the order so passed in case he is dis-satisfied with the same.
