The order dated 16.8.2012, non-compliance of which has been alleged by the petitioner mandated the grant of consequential service benefits as the inquiry and de novo inquiry against him and adverse orders passed on such inquiries were set aside by the writ Court.

Reply has been filed stating that all consequential benefits have been given and received by him on 15.7.2014. Copy of the order has been appended as Annexure R-1 and receipt pursuant thereto as Annexure R-2.

Amount is said to have been given to petitioner on 15.7.2014. Neither there is any counter affidavit filed by the petitioner nor there is any representation on his behalf.

If that be so then, instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such, leaving the petitioner to his remedies in law in the event of any shortfalls in payment.
