The petitioner, who had been working as Sewadar since 18.09.1996 and relieved from service on 21.09.2001 on the charge that he was drunk and indulged in rowdyism.

The petitioner filed CWP No. 18297 of 2001, which was disposed of vide order dated 28.11.2013. The impugned order was quashed and directions were issued to reinstate the petitioner in service with continuity of service, but without any monetary consequence.

Mr. M.S. Virk, learned counsel for the respondent states that vide resolution No. 123 dated 21.06.2014, the petitioner has been reinstated in service and he has been granted continuity of service in compliance with the order dated

28.11.2013, passed by this Court.

In view of the above, this petition is disposed of as infructuous.
