Learned senior counsel appearing for the respondent/contemners would advert to the averments contained in para 3 of the additional affidavit dated 22.09.2014 of the Managing Director, Pepsu Road Transport Corporation, Patiala and as per which, the commuted value of pension amounting to Rs.1,40,346/- stands released and paid to the petitioner vide cheque dated 24.04.2014. It has further been deposed that even an amount of Rs.25,000/- as directed by this Court vide order dated 22.07.2013 has also been paid.

Mr. Rupinder Khosla, learned senior counsel upon instructions from Mr. Himanshu Vasu, Legal Advisor of the respondent/corporation would further submit that even the interest component already stands released in favour of the petitioner.
