This petition is filed for the alleged disobedience of the order dated 29.09.2014 by which the parties were directed to maintain *status quo* till the appeal filed by the petitioner is decided by the Director, Department of Development and Panchayats, Punjab.

Counsel for the petitioner, with the help of photographs attached as Annexure P-3, has sought to argue that the respondents have violated the aforesaid order of *status quo* by taking possession of the land by installing a cemented pillar.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and examining the available record, I am of the considered opinion that these facts are not sufficient to issue notice of contempt to the respondents.

Consequently, the present petition is hereby dismissed being denuded of any merit.
