The order dated 21.7.2014 the non-compliance of which the petitioner alleges, required the respondents to consider the grievance of the petitioner as contained in the representation and take a decision thereon at an early date by passing an appropriate order in accordance with law, but in any case within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order, which has since been done by passing a speaking order as has been stated at bar by

the counsel for the respondents, rendering the instant petition infructuous, which is disposed of accordingly, leaving the petitioner to her remedies under the law in the event of her dissatisfaction against the order so passed.
