A short reply is filed on behalf of Dr. Tejinder Kaur Dhaliwal, Chairperson, Punjab School Education Board, SAS Nagar, Mohali/respondent No.1 dated 1.7.2015 in Court and a copy thereof is given to counsel for the petitioners.

It is averred in para No.3 of the said affidavit that arrears of pay w.e.f. October 2011 have now been paid to all the petitioners except petitioner No.19, namely, Anju Arora because her service book is not complete. It is further submitted that she would also be paid her arrears of pay as soon as her service book is prepared.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that petitioner No.15, namely, Sukhdeep Kaur, has also not been paid salary of six months when she was on maternity

leave. Although this is an altogether a different issue but learned counsel for the respondents has assured the Court that if a representation is made by the said petitioner to the respondents within two weeks from today in that regard then it would also be objectively considered and if the payment is due, the same would also be made to her within two weeks thereafter.

With these observations, the present petition is hereby disposed of.
