The order of the writ court envisaged the consideration of the case of the petitioner under the Haryana Compassionate Assistance to the Dependents of the Deceased Government Employees Rules, 2006 and after computing the same release the benefit w.e.f. 1.8.2006 i.e. the appointed date within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of the order. The petitioner was also held entitled to interest @ 8% per annum in the eventuality of the order not being complied within within the stipulated period of two months.

The respondents filed LPA and SLP against the order of this court which have also been dismissed. The respondents

contend that order Annexure R-1 has been passed granting the benefits to the petitioner. The order is, however, silent as far as interest component is concerned.

Learned counsel for the respondents on instructions from Shri Suresh Chand, Deputy Superintendent of the office of DGP, Haryana states that the benefits have been released to the petitioner.

If that is so, then the only issue of interest remains as it has not been stated specifically by the respondents that this component has also been satisfied.

The instant petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to the respondents to satisfy the interest component positively within a period of six weeks from today, if not already done, failing which the respondents shall be burdened with costs and consequences, and a presumption that they have willfully disobeyed the order of this court.
