It was not disputed that substantial amount of payment has been made to the petitioner on account of his retiral dues and according to the petitioner only an amount of Rs.45210/- was due as interest on delayed payment of pension and an amount of Rs.15054/- towards interest on delayed payment of gratuity. Subsequent to that order, an affidavit has been filed on 30.04.2015 giving the details of the payments made to the petitioner on account of the interest along with detail calculations and figures.

Be that as it may, then I am of the view that orders of this Court stands complied rendering the instant petition infructuous and hence disposed of having been as satisfied leaving the petitioner to his remedies in law in the event of his dissatisfaction against the short come, if any, in the payments.
