The petitioner had filed CWP No.27046 of 2013, praying for issuance of directions to the respondents for payment of interest on the delayed payment of retiral benefits, which were wrongly withheld even after acquittal of the petitioner in criminal case.

This petition was disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider the representation of the petitioner regarding release of interest on the delayed payment in the light of the relevant Government instructions and release the financial benefits to the petitioner within next two months.

In the reply filed by Sh. Raj Kumar, XEN, 'OP' Division, DHBVNL,

Rewari, it has been stated that the representation of the petitioner has been considered by the competent authority and the amount of Rs. 1,63,783/-, as interest on the delayed payment for the period from May, 2008 to August, 2011 has been paid to him on 30.05.2014. Thus, the order stands complied with.

This is not disputed by the learned counsel for the petitioner. He, however, states that earlier an amount of Rs. 1,86,498/- was withheld by the respondent from the pensionary benefits of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the respondent states that if the petitioner submits a representation in this regard, the same would be looked into by the respondent.

Disposed of as infructuous.
